- ✓ Take the entrance exam!
- ✓ Begin gathering applications for potential graduate schools.
- Create a calendar of deadlines for your application materials.
- ✓ Write applications, essays and/or personal statements using academic advisors, the <u>Learning Center</u> and <u>Center for Professional Excellence</u>.
- Request transcripts from each undergrad institution you have attended.
- ✓ Touch base with anyone writing your letters of recommendation.

PREPARE

- ✓ Make lists of programs, locations and subject areas of interest.
- ✓ Discuss options and application requirements with your academic advisor and/or career advisor at Center for Professional Excellence.
- ✓ Make contacts for letters of recommendation and notify them of letter due dates, qualifications, special requirements and other pertinent information.
- ✓ Sign up for appropriate entrance exam.
- ✓ Register early for test date.
- ✓ Note specific application procedures as designated by the school to which you are applying.
- ✓ Consider taking a preparatory course for the exam or using free practice tests.
- ✓ Look into internships, job opportunities, undergraduate research experiences and/or informational interviews in your field.

SELECT

- ✓ Determine sources of funding. File any applications including the <u>Free Application</u> for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- ✓ Double check with all graduate schools to ensure your application file is complete.
- Make arrangements to visit schools that accept you. Attend a class and talk to professors and current students.
- ✓ Send deposit to institution of your choice
