### CALL AND GUIDELINES FOR DEPARTMENTAL INITIATIVE PROPOSALS ACADEMIC YEAR 2000-2001

---

The Elmhurst College Faculty Development Committee invites proposals for grants to assist in funding departmental initiatives.

Two grants for up to \$2500 each are available.

Proposals should reflect a significant initiative affecting the entire department. The following are examples of such efforts:

- planning a new curriculum;
- developing a graduate program;
- creating a program of international study for departmental majors;
- increasing the use of technology as a means of improving teaching within the department;
- developing an initiative across the department's curriculum that addresses diversity, writing, entrepreneurship, *etc.*

Applications should outline the proposed activity, identify specific costs, and detail the anticipated benefit to students and faculty. ***Creativity is encouraged, as is consultation with the Faculty Development Committee.***

Proposals should either be submitted by the Department Chairperson, or be accompanied by a letter from the Department Chairperson endorsing the initiative.
