PRESIDENT'S AWARD for EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING

WHO MAY BE NOMINATED: Any **EC faculty member**, full-time or part-time, teaching undergraduate or graduate courses in any program during any term.

WHO MAY NOMINATE: Any group of three or more students, either from a student organization or an independent group of students.

HOW TO NOMINATE:

1. Obtain a nominating packet from either:
the **EC** Office of Academic Affairs (Goebel Hall 104) or
the Frick Center Information Desk.
2. Return **Intent to Nominate** form by **Wednesday, February 16, 2011** to the **EC** Office of Academic Affairs (Goebel Hall 104).
3. Return complete **Interview and Nomination** form by
Wednesday, February 23, 2011 to the **EC** Office of Academic Affairs (Goebel Hall 104).
4. Participate in an **interview** concerning your nominee.
(This is explained further on the nomination form.)
