

Instructions: FOR COMPLETION OF THE ICS PROGRAM COURSE PLAN

- 1) Fill in the personal information at the top of the Intercultural Studies Program Course Plan.

FOR THE ICS MINOR

- 2) Select 2 ICS Core Courses you intend to take for the minor. Indicate the term you intend to take each course. The purpose of the ICS Core Courses is to permit you to do your project work in each course on the cultural group or theme for your minor while at the same time to gain a broad understanding about cultural and social situations for a variety of minority and mainstream groups in the U.S. and internationally.
- 3) Indicate the term you intend to take each of the required ICS Courses
 - Take ICS 270 Intercultural Basics (1/2 course credit) near the beginning of your minor work.
 - Take ICS 271 Intermediate Intercultural Studies (1/2 course credit) after ICS 270. It can be the same term or a later term.
- 4) Select at least 2 courses for your ICS Minor Focus. Indicate the term you intend to take each. The purpose of the focus courses is to permit you to develop depth of understanding about the culture and social situation for your focus group. Note: No more than 2 of your 5 courses for the minor may be taken from the same department except ICS courses. No more than two can be used to meet other major or minor requirements.
- 5) Other Options: If you want to substitute an International Study course, an ICS 280/380 Intercultural Experiential course, or another relevant course (s) list the course (s) department, number, and name on the Other line. Indicate the term you intend to take the course. Be sure to consult with the ICS Director before making a substitution.

FOR THE ICS MAJOR

- 6) If you are selecting an ICS Major follow steps #1 through 5 for the Minor but fill it in on the right side of the Course Plan Under Major. You will need 3 core courses in addition to either BUS 271 or ICS 275. You will need 3 course credits for the Focus.

It will only list your minor or major as Intercultural Studies.
