Admission Requirements

The program is suited to students from many different educational backgrounds, including recent graduates. There are several business course prerequisites. You must have:

- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution or foreign equivalent
- Courses in financial accounting, managerial accounting and business finance (Requirement for all three courses can be satisfied by taking MBA Prep 300, an eight-week, online course. This course is offered four times per year)

Because this is an intensive, accelerated program, it is not recommended for people who are working full-time.
