Community Advisors (CAs) are college students trained to support the ELSA student’s living in the residence hall. Community Advisors assist in navigating the college living experience. In addition, all ELSA students living on-campus are required to have a life coach (also a college student) who help students acclimate to student life. Life coaches are hired and paid by student families and can interface with the student’s family. Typically a life coach can work with a student 3 to 5 hours per week and parents are responsible for the \$15 per hour.
