Elmhurst College requires criminal history records to be checked to support our school partners, however, the College review does not automatically mean a teacher candidate will be licensed to teach by the Illinois State Board of Education.

An arrest or conviction at any time prior to recommendation for licensure to ISBE must be reported to the Chairperson of the Department of Education, regardless of whether or not it is time to submit to a full Criminal Background Check.

Article 21-1 of the Illinois School Code requires that all persons who seek teacher licensure must be of good character. As one measure of fulfilling Article 21-1, you must mark each of the following statements as "Yes" or "No."
