- Students who wish to pursue a career in speech-language pathology whose completed bachelor's degree is in a field other than communication sciences and disorders require a series of prerequisite courses to prepare for application to graduate programs in speech-language pathology. This graduate preparation program is designed to meet expectations for core prerequisite knowledge of the Elmhurst College master's program in communication sciences and disorders. Students must apply separately for admission to the master's program. Requirements of other graduate programs may differ.
- Admissions Requirement: **Cumulative Undergraduate GPA of 3.2 or above** must be present at the time of application with a grade of B or higher in ENG 105 (Composition I, or equivalent writing courses) for admission to the program. Major GPA must be at least 3.2 to remain in the program and enroll in 300/400 level courses. See the College catalog for additional requirements.
- Illinois State Board of Education requires a Professional Educator's License in speech-language pathology to work in the schools. Refer to ISBE for current requirements: <https://www.isbe.net/Pages/PEL-School-Support-Ed-Lic.aspx> and discuss with your advisor.
