- **Cumulative GPA of 3.0** is required to begin 200-level core CSD courses. To declare the CSD major, completion of the core courses (i.e., CSD 203, 204, 234, 245, and 246), B or higher in ENG 105 & 106, and cumulative 3.2 GPA or higher is required. See the College catalog for additional requirements.
- Requirements for Licensure from the Illinois State Board of Education include a master's degree in speech-language pathology and EED 223 - Education of PK-12 Learners with Exceptionalities.
- **The Elmhurst College CSD major** requires a physical science course (CHM 100, CHM 101 or PHY 101) and a biological science course (BIO 100 or BIO 104), a statistics course (MTH 345 or PSY 355) and a social/behavioral science course based on requirements of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association for national certification.
- Transfer students must complete at least half of the course credits required for this major at Elmhurst College.
- Elmhurst College is in the process of converting from course credits to semester hours. Please note this will not change the relative value of each class, only the way it is transcribed. 1.0 course credit = 4 semester hours
