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## Spanish – World Language Educator Licensure

Part of the requirements for earning a Professional Educator License in Illinois at Elmhurst College includes successful completion of the Spanish Major and the World Language Education Major with a Spanish Concentration.

Admission to the College is separate from admission to the Teacher Education Program. Application to the Teacher Education Program requires a **minimum overall GPA of 2.75** from all institutions of higher learning. See the ***Application for Admission to a Teacher Education Program*** on the College website for application information. Students typically apply for admission in the spring term of their sophomore year or prior to transferring into the university as a junior.

**Spanish** majors must maintain a **major** GPA of 3.0 or higher. All courses taken to meet licensure requirements must be completed for a grade of C- (1.70) or higher. All educator preparation programs are subject to revisions required by changes from the Illinois State Board of Education.

**The following coursework constituting 30 semester hours or more must be completed in the Spanish Major to fulfill world language coursework. See the World Language Education major for the education coursework needed for licensure.**
