Part of the requirements for earning a Professional Educator License in Illinois at Elmhurst University includes successful completion of specific coursework in the Spanish, which has been aligned with the *American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Standards for the Preparation of Foreign Language Teachers*.

This Spanish Concentration fulfills requirements for the Spanish Major. Spanish majors must maintain a major GPA of 3.0 or higher and an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher. All courses taken to meet licensure requirements must be completed for a grade of C- (1.70) or higher. All educator preparation programs are subject to revisions required by changes from the Illinois State Board of Education.

The following coursework constituting 30 semester hours or more must be completed in the World Language Education Spanish Concentration.
