Elementary Teacher Education admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge (AoKs) in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (general education requirements). The additional AoKs to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA). There will be space for one such course or one of the math courses during the first semester of enrollment in the ELM program.

*This is done in one of three ways: 1.) Composite **ACT Plus Writing** score of at least 22 **and** a minimum 19 in Combined English/Writing (16 on writing for tests taken after 9/1/15) or 2.) Composite (math and critical reading) **SAT** score of at least 1030 **and** a minimum 450 in writing (or a composite **SAT with Essay** score of 1110 (Evidence-based Reading and Writing + Mathematics = 1110 or higher) and a minimum score of 26 on Writing and Language Test if the test was taken after March 5, 2016) or 3.)
