<b>Life Science:</b> <u>one course with a lab at least 3 sem. hrs. total</u> <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered</i>	<b>Life Science (all are LS):</b> BIOLO 1100 (for BIO 100), BIOLO 1110 (for BIO 105)
<b>Social Science:</b> two courses chosen from 2 of 4 areas (Satisfies AoK)  <i>These are recommended courses; other substituted courses will be considered.</i>	<b>Economics:</b> ECONO 2201 (for ECO 211), ECONO 2202 (for ECO 210) <b>Geography:</b> GEOGR 1100 for GEO 111 (SPA), GEOGR 1105 for GEO 112 (SPA) <b>History:</b> HISTO 1110 for HIS 111 (HA), HISTO 1120 for HIS 112 (HA), HISTO 1160 for HIS 116 (HA), HISTO 1130 for HIS 101 (HA), HISTO 1140 (for HIS 102 (HA), <b>Political Science:</b> POLS 1100 for POL 150 (SPA), POLS 1101 for POL 201 (SPA)

\*EYC Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 4 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (ECIC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Cognitive and Behavioral Science (CBS), Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA).
