These courses should be chosen to fulfill 2 different Areas of Knowledge requirements: Social and Political Analysis (SPA) and Historical Analysis (HA). Recommended courses. Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (ECIC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA). There would be room for one such course or one of the mathematics courses during the first semester of enrollment in the ELM program.

** Admission to Elmhurst University is not admission to a teacher education program.

***Taking the equivalent of EDU/PSY 311 will count toward the CBS Area of Knowledge but not for the Writing/Information Literacy tags; these tags will be fulfilled within the major.
