Life Science: one course with a lab <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.</i>	Life Science (all are LS): BIO 106 for BIO 105, BIO 121 for BIO 200, BIO 122 for BIO 201
Social Science: two courses chosen from 2 of 4 areas. These courses should be chosen to fulfill 2 different Areas of Knowledge requirements: Social and Political Analysis (SPA) and Historical Analysis (HA). <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.</i>	Economics: ECO 201 for ECO 211, ECO 202 for ECO 210, or ECO 110 Geography: GEO 120 or GEO 122 History: HIS 111 for HIS 301 (HA), HIS 112 for HIS 302 (HA), HIS 131 for HIS 111 (HA), HIS 132 for HIS 112 (HA) Political Science: PSC 101 for POL 201 (SPA), PSC 103 for POL 150 (SPA)

Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (ECIC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA).

*Admission to Elmhurst University is not admission to a teacher education program.

**Taking the equivalent of EDU/PSY 311 will count toward the CBS Area of Knowledge but not for the Writing/Information Literacy tags; these tags will be fulfilled within the major
