Social Science: two courses chosen from 2 of 4 areas. These courses should be chosen to fulfill 2 different Areas of Knowledge requirements: Social and Political Analysis (SPA) and Historical Analysis (HA). These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.	Economics: ECO 102 for ECO 211, ECO 103 for ECO 210, or ECO 100 Geography: GEO 106 for GEO 112 (SPA) History: HIS 151 for HIS 301 (HA), HIS 152 for HIS 302 (HA), HIS 121 for HIS 111 (HA), HIS 122 for HIS 112 (HA) Political Science: PSC 150 for POL 201 (SPA) or PSC 120 for POL 150 (SPA)

Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (ECIC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA).

* Admission to Elmhurst University is not admission to a teacher education program.

**Taking the equivalent of EDU/PSY 311 will count toward the CBS Area of Knowledge but not for the Writing/Information Literacy tags; these tags will be fulfilled within the major.
