## World Language Education: French Concentration

Part of the requirements for earning a Professional Educator License in Illinois at Elmhurst University includes successful completion of specific coursework in the French, which has been aligned with the *American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Standards for the Preparation of Foreign Language Teachers*.

**This French Concentration fulfills requirements for the French Major.** French majors must maintain a major GPA of 3.0 or higher and an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher. All courses taken to meet licensure requirements must be completed for a grade of C- (1.70) or higher. All educator preparation programs are subject to revisions required by changes from the Illinois State Board of Education.
