Physical Science: one course with a lab chosen from 2 areas. <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.</i>	Physical Science (all are PS): CHEM 100 for CHM 101, CHEM 101 for CHM 211, PHYS 101 for PHY 111 Earth and Space Science (all are PS): GEOG 112 for GEO 102; GEOG 111 for GEO 105
Life Science: one course with a lab chosen from 2 areas. <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.</i>	Life Science (all are LS): BIO 149 for BIO 100, BIO 151 for BIO 200, BIO 152 for BIO 201
Social Science: two courses chosen from 2 of 4 areas. These courses should be chosen to fulfill 2 different areas of knowledge requirements: Social and Political Analysis (SPA) and Historical Analysis (HA). <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.</i>	Economics: ECON 103 for ECO 211, ECON 104 for ECO 210 History: HIST 103 for HIS 101 (HA), HIST 104 for HIS 102 (HA), HIST 105 for HIS 111 (HA), HIST 106 for HIS 112 (HA) Political Science: PSCI 101 for POL 201, PSCI 102 for POL 202 (SPA)

Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (ECIC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA).

*Admission to Elmhurst University is not admission to a teacher education program.

**Taking the equivalent of EDU/PSY 311 will count toward the CBS Area of Knowledge but not for the Writing/Information Literacy tags; these tags will be fulfilled within the major.
