WHAT IS AN HSI?

HSI stands for Hispanic-Serving Institution. An institution can apply for this designation if they have an enrollment of undergraduate, full-time equivalent students that is at least 25% Hispanic students. This designation is purely based on enrollment.

WHAT IS A TITLE V DHSI GRANT?

The Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions (DHSI) Program provides discretionary grants to assist HSIs to expand educational opportunities for, and improve the attainment of, Hispanic students. These grants also enable HSIs to expand and enhance their academic offerings, program quality, and institutional stability.

WHAT CAN THE FUNDS BE USED FOR?

Title V DHSI funds may be used for construction, faculty and curriculum development, purchase of educational materials, student service programs, and more. This list is not exhaustive.

WHAT CAN'T THE FUNDS BE USED FOR?

The Title V DHSI Grant is a capacity-building grant for an institution and few funds are allotted for individual student use. Funds may not be used for scholarships, activities that are operational in nature rather than developmental, student activities, and more. This list is not exhaustive.

WHAT ARE THEGRANTGOALS?

Elmhurst University received a 5-year Title V DHSI grant in October 2022
