

Housing and Residence Life Move-Out Preparation Checklist

In order to ensure that our buildings are properly vacated and prepared for the summer, we ask that you complete this checklist prior to departing at the end of the year.

Students must move-out within 24 hours of their last final. Residential facilities close at 10:00 AM on Friday, May 24

Checklist (save this document and mark off items as they are completed)

- Pack/remove all your belongings
- Donate lightly used items that you no longer want/need at a donation location
- Clean your room/suite/apartment (refer to Room Cleaning/Prep Instructions for detailed information)
- Empty/defrost/clean/unplug mini-fridges*
 - st full-size fridges in apartments and houses should be cleaned but remain plugged in
- Dispose of all waste/recycling in proper locations
- Return room furniture to original position (beds bunked, shelf on dresser, hutch on desk)
- Close and lock windows; open blinds/shades
- Set thermostat to ON and to 72°F (22°C)
- Double check your room/suite/apartment for any missed items
- Ensure appliances and water faucets are turned off
- Turn out lights and lock the door
- Check-Out: Obtain an express checkout envelope from any Housing and Residence Life staff member or Public Safety. Fill out envelope, seal access card, stairwell key, room key and apartment building key inside. Turn envelope in at <u>Public Safety</u> before leaving campus.

Following the departure of all residents of a space, Facilities Management staff will inspect each unit for damages and/or abandoned property. A \$100.00 Improper Check-Out fee may be assessed if any item listed above is not complete.

Unreturned keys cost at least \$100.00 and additional charges may be applied for any damages discovered during these inspections.

	All personal items have been removed
General	Surfaces and furnishings are free of stickers/graffiti/stains
	Tape/3M strips/hook/etc. have been removed from surfaces without damaging surface
	University fixtures/finishes/furnishings have not been altered
	Carpets are vacuumed
	All tile/laminate/hardwood floors are swept
	Screens are properly installed on all windows
	Window blinds/shades are in place and in good, working condition
	Door viewer (peep hole) is in place and in working condition
	Door hardware is in place and in working condition
	Closet doors are attached and functional
	Closet shelves/floors are clean
-	Any personal furnishings have been removed
	University furniture allocated to the room is present and in good condition
	Furniture has been returned to original configuration
	Furniture does not block walkways, doors, heating/ventilation units
e	No unauthorized furniture (lounge furniture) is present
Furniture	Drawers/shelves are empty and clean
	Bookcase is attached to dresser
	Hutch is attached to desk
	Bedframe is properly attached to head/footboards, beds are bunked
	Mattress is on bed and in good condition
	Bedframe and mattress are clean
	Smoke detectors are in place and working
) Other	Outlet covers and light switch plates are in place
	No items are left behind/forgotten (check in and behind furniture)
	Personal Items have been removed
Bathroom (where applicable)	Bathroom surfaces and fixtures are free of mold/mildew
	Toilet (including in/around toilet bowl) is clean
	Tub/Shower area is clean
	University-provided shower curtain is present and clean
	Countertops/sink and cabinets are clean and free of personal belongings
	Personal items have been removed
Kitchen (where applicable)	Appliances are clean and in working condition
	Floor has been swept
	Food/debris/spills have been removed/cleaned
Ki /here	Countertops/cabinet/sink are clean
5	Items are removed from cabinets
