### Advising Sheet for Elementary Teacher Education at Elmhurst University

- Students apply for admission to the program beginning Feb 1 prior to their fall start term

<b>Social Science:</b> <u>two courses chosen from 2 of 4 areas</u>  These courses should be chosen to fulfill 2 different Areas of Knowledge requirements: Social and Political Analysis (SPA) and Historical Analysis (HA).	<b>Economics:</b> ECO 101, ECO 102, <b>Geography:</b> GEG 105 <b>History</b> (all are HA): HIS 103, HIS 104, HIS 105, HIS 106 <b>Political Science</b> (SPA): POL 201  <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered</i>

Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (IC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA). Such courses can be found on the Elmhurst University website (<https://www.elmhurst.edu/admission/transfer-adult-students/>) under “Transfer Guides” or through “Transferology.” Students should have no more than two of the additional IC courses remaining for admission to the School of Education.

***Admission to Elmhurst University is not admission to a teacher education program. There is a separate application process.***
