Advising Sheet for Elementary Teacher Education at Elmhurst University

- Students apply for admission to the program beginning Feb 1 prior to their fall start term
- ALL COURSES COMPLETED WITH “C-” (1.70) OR HIGHER AND CUMULATIVE GPA OF 2.750.

Social Science: <u>two courses chosen from 2 of 4 areas</u> These courses should be chosen to fulfill 2 different Areas of Knowledge requirements: Social and Political Analysis (SPA) and Historical Analysis (HA).	Economics: ECO 102, ECO 103, ECO 100 Geography (all are SPA): GEO 106 History (all are HA): HIS 151, HIS 152, HIS 121, HIS 122 Political Science (all are SPA): PSC 150, PSC 120 <i>These are recommended courses - substitute courses will be considered.</i>

Elementary Teacher Education program admission requirements should fulfill at least 5 of the 9 Areas of Knowledge in the Elmhurst University Integrated Curriculum (IC, general education requirements). The additional Areas of Knowledge to be completed are: Inquiry into Ethics & Justice (IEJ), Religious Studies in Context (RSC), Literature (LIT), and Fine Arts (FA). Such courses can be found on the Elmhurst University website (<https://www.elmhurst.edu/admission/transfer-adult-students/>) under “Transfer Guides” or through “Transferology.” Students should have no more than two of the additional IC courses remaining for admission to the School of Education.
