- Contact the Title IX Office
- Submit a report, including an anonymous report, via QR code

Provide information about rights, resources, and options under the Non-Discrimination and Non-Harassment Policy

Provide information about the applicable policies and procedures

Help with supportive measures, such as course-related extensions, No Contact Orders, and changes in housing
