Elmhurst University requires criminal history records to be checked to support our school partners, however, the University review does not automatically mean a teacher candidate will be licensed to teach by the Illinois State Board of Education.

An arrest or conviction at any time prior to recommendation for licensure to ISBE must be reported to the Chair of the Department of Education, regardless of whether or not it is time to submit to a full Criminal Background Check.

Article 21-1 of the Illinois School Code requires that all persons who seek teacher licensure must be of good character. As one measure of fulfilling Article 21-1, you must mark each of the following statements as “Yes” or “No.”

OVERVIEW OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR APPLICATION TO A TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM AT ELMHURST UNIVERSITY.

One recommendation form in sealed envelopes signed across the flap by the recommender. Complete the top section of the form before giving it to a recommender.

A copy of a recent (within one year of application) Illinois State Police criminal background fingerprint check. The copy will be returned to the applicant upon the completion of processing of the application. (See enclosed policy.)

A 500-word or less word-processed personal statement answering the following two questions:

1. Why do you want to enter the profession of teaching in secondary schools?
2. Why have you chosen the particular subject area and other endorsements?

A copy of your most recent transcripts, including all completed college-level coursework with evidence of a cumulative GPA of 2.750 or higher. Transcripts will also be reviewed for major GPA requirements, if major coursework has been completed.

€ Current students may print a *Self-Service* transcript that shows all courses completed, accepted in transfer, and in progress.

€ Transcripts will be provided for transfer students by the Office of Admission.

Note. If required courses are in progress, teacher candidates may be offered admission but must provide evidence of successful completion to continue in a teacher education program.

Policies and Procedures for Admission to Teacher Education

APPLICATION DATES

Applications may be submitted during the sophomore year while required coursework is in progress.

Applications will be accepted for fall admissions beginning June 15

Applications will be accepted for spring admissions beginning December 15

Admission decisions are made monthly and decision letters will be mailed within 30 days of an admission decision. Admission status information will not be provided in person, over the telephone, or via e-mail.

1. If an applicant meets admission requirements, but space is no longer available in the specific program for the requested term, admission will be offered for the following term in which the program accepts new candidates. Completed applications are reviewed monthly in the order received. An incomplete application will have a receipt date indicating when all required materials were finally received by the School of Education.
2. The *Director of Teacher Education Admissions* will inform applicants in writing of admission decisions. Applicants with minimal qualifications may be denied admission. There is no appeal for applicants who are denied admission based on the quality of their application. An established appeal procedure is available for applicants who feel that their applications were not properly processed.
3. Students may not reapply to any teacher education program once they have been denied admission.
4. Applicants admitted to a teacher education program may not request a change to another program, instead a full application must be made to a different program. Field hours completed for a previous program may not be credited toward the new program. Changing programs could delay program completion.
5. Admission to a teacher education program does not guarantee admission to student teaching. All teacher candidates must meet requirements for remaining in a teacher education program and must apply for student teaching. Review of teacher candidates is on-going. Candidates who are removed from a teacher education program or not admitted to student teaching have the right to appeal the decision to the University's *Teacher Education Committee*.
