

Video Submission Instructions for Elmhurst University

As part of your graduate application to the master's in speech-language pathology program at Elmhurst University, please submit a video response to three topics. This document will guide you through the video creation and submission process.

In short, you will:

1. Record a brief video answering three topic areas.
2. Upload your brief video as an "Unlisted" video to YouTube
3. Copy/paste your video link into a custom question in CSDCAS.

Please see below for step-by-step instructions for each task.

1. Record a brief video in which you answer the following topic areas within a 1 minute time limit per topic:

(1) Tell us about something you have done that you are proud of. What did it reveal to you about yourself?

(2) Tell us about a time you disagreed with someone on your team, a co-worker, or a classmate. How did you handle it, and looking back, is there anything you would do differently?

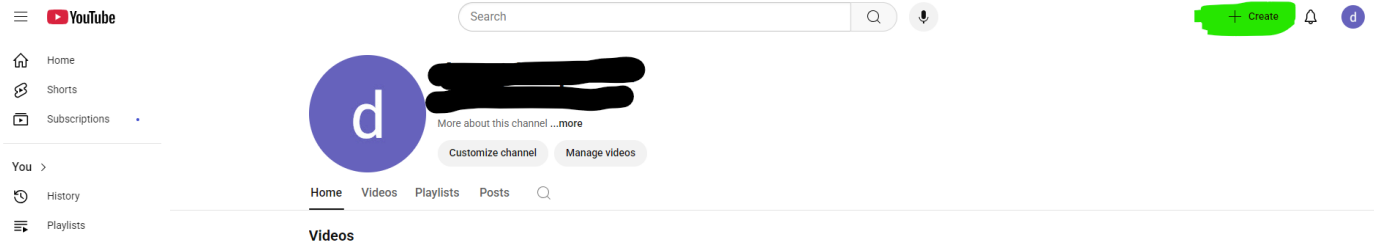
(3) Tell us about a mistake you made. How you respond and what did it teach you about yourself as a learner or future clinician?

- a. Note: Videos may be recorded via phone, computer, web-conferencing software like Zoom, or another way.

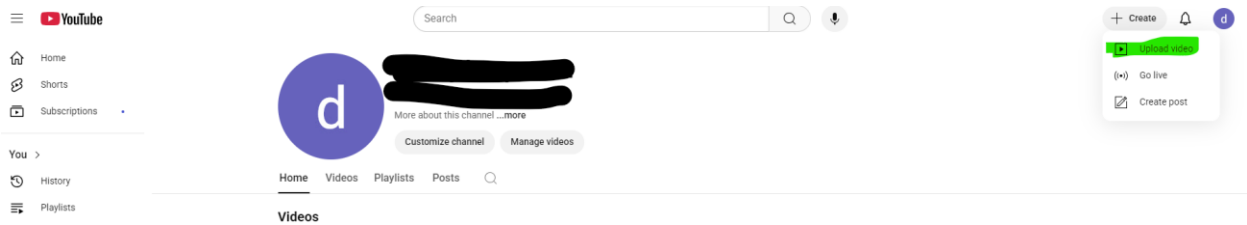
2. Upload your brief video to YouTube by following the steps below:

a. Go to youtube.com and login to your account (or create one, if you do not already have one)

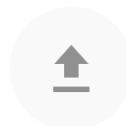
b. In the top right-hand corner, click on “Create”



c. Click on “Upload video”



d. Select the video file you wish to upload



Drag and drop video files to upload
Your videos will be private until you publish them.

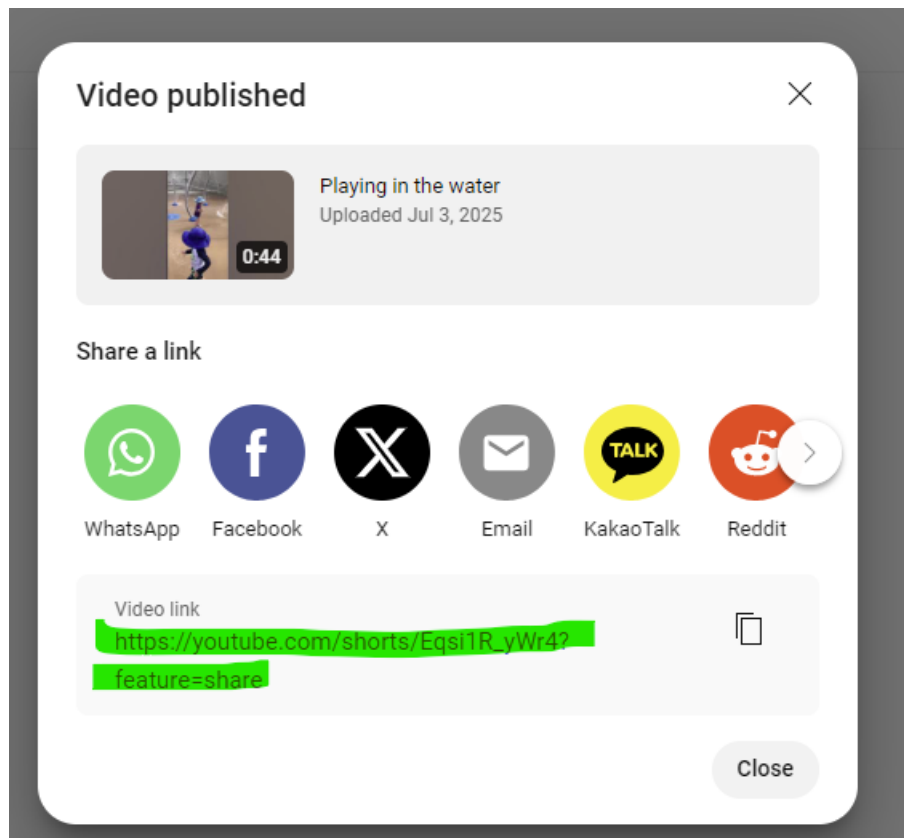
